The Undergraduate Research and Creativities (URECA) Center announces the availability, by way of the Starr Foundation, of grants in support of undergraduate students who will be presenting research findings at professional meetings or at the annual meeting of the National Conference on Undergraduate Research. Those eligible to apply and the priority order in which each will be considered are as follows:

1. Current and former recipients of Wake Forest Research Fellowships;
2. Students working on departmental honors projects;
3. Undergraduate students engaged in mentored or sponsored research across the departments in the College and in the Schools of Business.

Starr Grants are awarded up to \$700.00 for the purpose of meeting expenses related to the presentation and/or travel costs. Awards will be made quarterly.

To apply for a Starr Grant, students must complete an application (available on-line or in the Office of the Dean of the College, Reynolda 104, and the Office of the Associate Dean for Special Academic Projects, Reynolda 102) and submit it to Dean Orser by one of the deadlines listed above. Notifications to applicants will be made approximately 3 weeks following each submission date.

If your travel is outside the United States, you must complete an International Travel Form and the Assumption of Risk & Release Form available on the Center for International Studies web site at www.wfu.edu/cis. These forms must be completed and turned in to the Center for International Studies prior to any awards being made.
